

CURRENT PROTOCOLS AND GUIDELINES @ PSC&HS
These are the up-to-date guidelines that PSC&HS currently has in place
(as of June 14, 2021):

Masks

VACCINATED ADULTS AND MINORS

- Will no longer be required to wear a mask while in the building
- Vaccinated coaches are still required to wear a mask while teaching any unvaccinated student

UNVACCINATED ADULTS AND MINORS

- Will be required to wear a mask while inside the building (this includes while on the ice)
- This includes skaters, coaches, staff and spectators
- If you are unvaccinated, we are depending on your responsibility to be honest and abide by this policy
- Coaches will be required to wear a mask while teaching unvaccinated students (adults and minors)

Parents/Spectators

Parents and spectators are allowed in the building. See above regarding masks. All should practice social distancing. If you are watching from the bleachers, please sit behind your child's belongings. If watching from Lower Lounge – please see below.

Lower Lounge

The lower lounge is open for use.

- If vaccinated, no mask will be required; if not vaccinated, a mask will be required to be worn
- There will be a limited number of tables and chairs available; please limit number of people at each table to 3. Please sit in the configured seating provided; no rearranging chairs.
- Continue to practice social distancing while in the lounge
- Food is allowed in the lounge; however, unvaccinated people should eat in our outside eating area so that masks may be removed while eating
- Lower lounge should not be used for socializing between sessions; please feel free to use the provided outdoor seating area to gather with your fellow skaters

Locker Rooms

The Ladies and Men's locker rooms are open for use by our female and male adult skaters (over 18 years of age). The Girl's and Boy's locker rooms will remain closed at this time. (Junior skaters will continue to use public rest rooms.)

Upper Lounge

The upper lounge will be available for Club approved off-ice classes only. It will not be open for individual usage.

Warm-Up Room

The warm-up room will remain open using the current protocols in place which include a maximum of four people in the room at any time (including the coach). Masks may be removed if all in the room are vaccinated. Reservations to use the room will continue to be required (through the office).

Reminders:

*All persons entering the building should continue to practice social distancing while on and off the ice, in the locker rooms, in the lower lounge and while at the Music Box.

*Any partnering is done at your own risk as social distancing is not possible. If partner or coach tests positive for Covid-19, please refer to the Quarantine Guidelines (see office for up-to-date guidelines)

*Every skater should select a space on a chair or the bleachers to leave their bag or belongings and to tie their skates. This space should be their "socially distant" spot for the duration of the session. Please remember to continue to social distance while on the bleachers or sitting in front of the lower lounge.

*Skate Shop sales are done by appointment only. Please call 610-642-8700 to arrange appointment with Fran Mycek.

Quarantine Guidelines - please see the office for up-to-date protocols

Skaters should continue to stop at the front door and sign-in for all sessions that they are skating.

The health and safety of everyone relies on the integrity of all of us to abide by the appropriate guidelines for their personal vaccination status.

This policy will be in effect for daily skating. Policies may be different for test sessions, competitions and Learn to Skate. Please refer to the specific event for their specific policy.
