

## PSC&HS Fall Session Protocols and Guidelines Effective September 7, 2021

PSC&HS continues to strive to keep our members, coaches, and staff as safe as possible while ON and OFF the ice. The following protocols and guidelines will be in effect with the Fall Session beginning on September 7<sup>th</sup> and until further notice. If restrictions or guidelines should change, you will be notified accordingly.

### Masks

Everyone entering the building will be required to wear a mask at all times while in the facility. Skaters may remove their mask during a program run-through.

### Locker Rooms

All locker rooms will be open for use; however, the locker rooms are available for taking skates on/off, changing clothes and storing your belongings (please refrain from using the locker rooms as a socializing area). Masks should be worn at all times while in the locker rooms. Please be sure to take your personal belongings with you or store them in your locker when leaving the room so that proper cleaning and disinfecting can be completed.

### Lower Lounge

Please continue to social distance as much as possible while in the lounge. Masks should be worn at all times while in the lounge.

### Warm-Up Room

Current protocols are still in place. Max of 4 people in room at any time (including instructor). Masks must be worn at all times. Wipe down surfaces and equipment before leaving room. No skates, food or drink allowed in the room at any time. Anyone under 12 must have Coach/Instructor supervision.
